

OCE Laundry Recruitment

OCE Laundry is looking for worker candidates for our general laundry operation. Workers will also be considered to participate in the OCE Laundry Certification Program, a 12-month industry certification.

Requirements:

- Applicants must have between 3 years to 10 years left on their sentence,
- Preference will be given to those with over 6 years left.
- They must be housed in COMPLEX 1 OR be eligible to be housed in COMPLEX 1.
- Must have GED or HS Diploma.

Work Ethic:

- Applicants must be team players and able to work well with staff and other AIC associates. "See work, Do work" is our motto.
- They will be expected to lift up to 50 pounds and stand for long periods.
- Work hours are Monday through Friday, 7:30 am to 4:00 pm.

Physical Plant Painter Recruitment

SRCI Physical Plant has an opening on the Paint Crew. **In order to apply, all of the following criteria must be met (no exceptions):**

- Clear conduct for 1 1/2 years (No Major DR or Program Failures)
- Must already be housed in Complex 1-A, 1-B, or 1-C
- Classification 3 or less
- No history of escape, or arson
- 10 years or less remaining on sentence



Job Duties:

- Applies coats of paint, varnish, stain, enamel, or lacquer to decorate and protect interior or exterior surfaces, trimmings, and fixtures of buildings and other structures.
- Reads work orders or receives instructions from Supervisor regarding painting.
- Smooths surfaces using sandpaper, brushes, or steel wool.
- Removes old paint from surfaces using paint remover, scraper, or wire brush to prepare surfaces for painting.
- Fills nail holes, cracks, and joints with caulk, putty, plaster or other filler using caulking gun and putty knife.
- Selects premixed paints, or mixes required portions of pigment, oil and thinning and drying substances to prepare paint that matches specified colors.
- Removes fixtures such as pictures and electric switch covers from walls prior to painting by using a screwdriver.
- Spreads drop cloths over floors and room to protect surfaces during painting.
- Paints surfaces using brushes, spray gun, or paint rollers.
- Sets up scaffolding or ladders to perform tasks above ground level.

Physical Plant Carpenter Shop Recruitment

SRCI Physical Plant has an opening in the Carpenter Shop. In order to apply, all of the following criteria must be met (no exceptions):

- Clear conduct for 1 1/2 years (No Major DR or Program Failures)
- Must already be housed in Complex 1-A, 1-B, or 1-C
- Classification 3 or less
- No history of escape, or arson
- 10 years or less remaining on sentence

Job Duties may include:

- Reads work orders or receives instructions from Supervisor regarding carpentry.
- Legible handwriting, basic math and filing abilities.
- Able to lift 50 lbs.
- Capable of pushing carts of tools to units.
- Good Work Ethic and Attitude
- Basic trouble shooting skills and aptitude of construction techniques.
- Have basic skills in Carpentry.
- Work well in team environment.
- Have basic knowledge of hand tools.
- Have basic knowledge of test equipment.
- Be able to follow detailed instructions.
- Be able to follow operational and safety guidelines.
- Be able to operate light equipment IE: man lifts, hydraulic jacks, scissor lifts, etc.
- Be familiar with products such as concrete and various types of wood products, wall-board types, floor insulation, and ceiling coverings.
- Have a basic understanding of a blueprint or construction drawing and be able to follow its use from paper to actual construction.

SRCI Physical Plant has 4 AIC Plumber position openings. In order to apply, all of the following criteria must be met (no exceptions):

- Clear conduct for 1 1/2 years (No Major DR or Program Failures).
- Must already be housed in Complex 1-A, 1-B, or 1-C.
- Classification 3 or less • No history of escape, or arson.
- 10 years or less remaining on sentence.

You must have a good work ethic & attitude, work in team environment, follow detailed instructions, and follow operational/safety guidelines. Have basic skills in: trouble shooting, hand tools, test equipment, carpentry, plumbing/janitorial, electrical/metal fabrication, mechanical/welding, and hydraulic/pneumatic systems. Be able to install and replace pipes, valves, drain systems, basins, tubs, faucets, lavatories, sinks, gates, hydrants, water heaters, dishwashers, other plumbing fixtures, pressure valves and equipment; repair breaks in pipes; clean and open drains and other lines; repair water pumps and heaters, steam traps condense lines; install and repair steam and gas systems; troubleshoots and repair SRCI systems. Be able to work with human waste.

From the Administrative Rules Program

Below is the list of status changes made to DOC administrative rules since 03/01/21.

PROPOSED RULES:

291-127 Visiting

- These rule amendments are needed to clarify the department's eligibility criteria for prospective visitors and to establish that the amendments to OAR 291-127-0415(2) (i) apply retroactively to all persons who have previously submitted an application, or who submit an application, to visit with an adult in custody (inmate) prior to, on, and after the effective date of these rule amendments.
- Last day to provide comments: 06/01/21
- Temporary Rules Effective: 04/01/21 – 09/27/21

PERMANENT RULES

291-097 Prison Term Modification

- Amends the rules to implement statutory language changes and to clarify rule language to provide for easier understanding of the processes.
- Effective: 04/07/21

291-100 Sentence Computation

- These rule amendments clarify what information the Department needs in a judgment in order to fully compute the sentences imposed in that judgment. In addition, these rule amendments are needed to explain how the Department will interpret potentially ambiguous language in judgments that impose one or more consecutive sentences.
- Effective: 04/06/21

291-201 AIC Assignment Management

- Amends the rules to align with updated statutory language and references.
- Effective: 04/16/21

Rulemaking comments must be provided to the DOC Rules Coordinator in writing at the address in the rulemaking notice. Communications submitted should be limited to providing comments on only one division/topic per communication. Do not include multiple divisions/topics in one communication, they will be returned. DOC rules are available for review and copies in the AIC law library.
