T4C STM Programming Communication

Soon, randomly selected AIC's who are actively on an STM caseload will be expected to both participate in and complete the cognitive and behavioral program "Thinking for A Change" (T4C). This programming will be conducted twice weekly with a new Facilitator Ms. Grendahl. This program is not associated with BHS in any way. The goal of this programming is to help create a change in both thinking and behavior for those on the STM caseload. Once selected into T4C, the expectation is to complete the programming which will last approximately (15 weeks). In the future, this programming will be used for AIC's who are releasing or recently released from Intensive Management Unit (IMU) or who are predicated on the caseload via the Risk Associated with Segregation Placement (RASP).
