PHYSICAL PLANT RECRUITMENT—DOOR CREW

SRCI Physical Plant has an opening on a Door Crew. In order to apply, all of the following criteria must be met (no exceptions):

- Clear conduct for 1 1/2 years (No Major DR or Program Failures)
- Must already be housed in Complex 1-A, 1-B, or 1-C
- Classification 3 or less
- No history of escape, or arson
- 10 years or less remaining on sentence

You must have a general knowledge of all hand tools, power tools, basic knowledge of electrical test equipment, basic mechanical skills, work well with others, able to complete assigned tasks, and able to troubleshoot problems on equipment.

If you are interested in this program and meet all of the above requirements, send a completed Physical Plant Work Assignment Application; along with an Inmate Communication expressing your interest to Physical Plant (B344). The applications will be screened by members of the Physical Plant staff. Qualified applicants will need to pass a security screening before being contacted for an interview. Submit applications by January 20, 2023.

BASIC SKILLS UPGRADE CLASS RETURNS

SRCI Education Department is excited to announce that the Basic Skills Upgrade Class (BSU Class is returning!

Beginning in February, AIC that already have a verified credential (GED, HSD, or higher degree) that want to enroll in Basic Skills Upgrade classes to improve their Math, Reading, and /or writing skills will have that opportunity. There are a limited number of class seats available: classes are only available in Complex 2 and Complex 3 at this time.

A waitlist for AICs requesting to participate will be maintained by the Education Department. As there are limited class seats AICs will be assigned based on schedule availability

(if you work during the Class period, you will be waitlisted until your schedule allows for you to be enrolled).

Any AICs (from Complex 2 or 3) wanting to be considered for the Basic Skills Upgrade Class need to send a kyte to Education Mailbox 334, Attn: Ms. Brinck and must include the following: Why you want to enroll in the Basic Skills Upgrade Class and Identify your educational goals.

- DO NOT submit numerous CD28's to circumvent the process to attempt to receive additional meals. If additional CD28's is processed for you for the same meal you will not be afforded the opportunity for a refund or receive an additional meal.
- If your request is not filled out Completely and properly, your CD28 will not be processed
- All requests must be received to M. Vokral by February 15th, 2023. A specific schedule of the meal dates will be sent later. The first meal will be offered on March 7, 2023.

SRCI Physical Plant has an opening for an AIC Plumber position. In order to apply, all of the following criteria must be met (no exceptions):

- Clear conduct for 1 1/2 years (No Major DR or Program Failures)
- Must already be housed in Complex 1-A, 1-B, or 1-C
- Classification 3 or less
- No history of escape, or arson
- 10 years or less remaining on sentence

You must have a good work ethic & attitude, work in team environment, follow detailed instructions, and follow operational/safety guidelines. Have basic skills in: trouble shooting, hand tools, test equipment, carpentry, plumbing/janitorial, electrical/metal fabrication, mechanical/welding, and hydraulic/pneumatic systems.

Be able to install and replace pipes, valves, drain systems, basins, tubs, faucets, lavatories, sinks, gates, hydrants, water heaters, dishwashers, other plumbing fixtures, pressure valves and equipment; repair breaks in pipes; clean and open drains and other lines; repair water pumps and heaters, steam traps condense lines; install and repair steam and gas systems; troubleshoots and repair SRCI systems. Be able to work with human waste.

The applications will be screened by members of the Physical Plant Staff. Qualified applicants will need to pass a security screening before being contacted for an interview. Submit application by January 26, 2023.

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is available to take effect on July 1, 2023.

All incarcerated individuals who meet the general eligibility requirements are eligible, regardless of conviction or sentence length.

FAFSA funds will cover tuition, textbooks, and fees.
