## Greenhouse Management Graduation

Our second annual Green House Management class was a success. This year it was facilitated by alumni AICs that took the class last year. This is a read and discussion class where throughout the 11-week course, they are working on a tabletop creation of a greenhouse of their choice. They then gave 15-minute presentations to Sustainability Facilitator Ms. Goertzen and Physical Plant Manager Ms. MacKenzie and were graded on their presentations by their facilitators and Ms. Goertzen. The presentations had to include concepts learned in the class like types of irrigation, type of materials used to build the greenhouse, costs, and calendars of rotation to name a few. The Growing Gardens/Lettuce Grow Director, Rima Green, said their test essays were some of the best she had ever read. The class had a mid-term and final tests. Grades throughout the class were above average and their presentations were exceptional in their detail. Ms. Green said, "They did great! Look at those scores!", about the final course grades. Student's final grades ranged between 95 and 99 percent. The garden class facilitators Frank Nicholson and James Davis are planning to start the second Seed to Supper class in November, and our 3rd annual Sustainability Garden class in the spring. Although our gardens were not as successful this year our AIC garden crew continue to learn to overcome the challenges.

## **JOB OPPORTUNITIES**

### **Srci Physical Plant has an opening on the Paint Crew.**

In order to apply, all of the following criteria must be met (no exceptions):

- Clear conduct for 1 1/2 years (No Major DR or Program Failures)
- Must already be housed in Complex 1-A, 1-B, or 1-C
- Classification 3 or less
- No history of escape, or arson
- 10 years or less remaining on sentence.

Job Duties:

- Applies coats of paint, varnish, stain, enamel, or lacquer to decorate and protect interior or exterior surfaces, trimmings, and fixtures of buildings and other structures.
- Reads work orders or receives instructions from Supervisor regarding painting.
- Smooths surfaces using sandpaper, brushes, or steel wool.
- Removes old paint from surfaces using paint remover, scraper, or wire brush to prepare surfaces for painting.
- Fills nail holes, cracks, and joints with caulk, putty, plaster or other filler using caulking gun and putty knife.
- Selects premixed paints, or mixes required portions of pigment, oil and thinning and drying substances to prepare paint that matches specified colors.
- Removes fixtures such as pictures and electric switch covers from walls prior to painting by using a screwdriver.
- Spreads drop cloths over floors and room to protect surfaces during painting.
- Paints surfaces using brushes, spray gun, or paint rollers.
- Sets up scaffolding or ladders to perform tasks above ground level.

If you are interested in this program and meet all of the above requirements, send a completed Physical Plant Work Assignment Application; along with an Inmate Communication expressing your interest to Physical Plant (B344). The applications will be screened by members of the Physical Plant staff. Qualified applicants will need to pass a security screening before being contacted for an interview. Applications must be received by November 22, 2024.

### **Srci Physical Plant has an opening for 2 HVAC positions at the Central Plant.**

In order to apply, all of the following criteria must be met (no exceptions):

- Clear conduct for 1 1/2 years (No Major DR or Program Failures)
- Must be eligible to be housed in 2I, 2J, 3I, or 3J
- Classification 3 or less
- No history of arson or escape
- 10 years or less remaining on sentence.

Previous HVAC experience is preferred. You must have a general knowledge of hand power tools, basic mechanical skills, work well with others, able to complete assigned tasks, and able to troubleshoot problems on equipment. If you are interested in this program and meet all of the above requirements, send a completed Physical Plant Work Assignment Application; along with an AIC Communication expressing your interest to Physical Plant (B344). The applications will be screened by members of the Physical Plant staff. Qualified applicants that are interviewed will need to pass a security screening prior to being hired. Submit applications by November 22, 2024.

### **Food Services is Currently Hiring for Multiple Production Kitchen, Bakery, Special Events, and Staff Dining Positions.**

Applicants need to be motivated to succeed. Advancement is possible for the right applicants. Qualifications include: Minimum of 45 days clear conduct. Prior Food Service Experience (although not necessary for the right applicants) Ability to work early mornings or into the evening shift- AM and PM shifts available. An awareness of the need to complete work within tight timelines. An Ability to get along well with others and work in a job that is sometimes high- pressure.
