Mail Rule Revision

Effective January 13, 2025, the Mail Rule has been revised to address concerns regarding safety, security, and the well-being of both Adults in Custody (AICs) and Staff. Mail postmarked after this date will be subject to the revised rule.

SOME OF THE NEW REQUIREMENTS THAT FRIENDS AND FAMILY OF AICS SHOULD BE AWARE OF INCLUDE: Incoming mail must be in pen, lead pencil, or be typewritten or photocopied. Incoming mail must be written on standard weight (20 pound or less) white paper. This is standard copy/print paper. Incoming mail must be enclosed in a **commercially produced envelope using standard weight (20 pound or less) white paper that is no larger than 9"x12"**.

EXAMPLES OF ITEMS THAT WILL BE REFUSED: Any non-white envelope. **Envelopes larger than 9"x12"**. Envelopes that are not commercially produced. Envelopes made of cardboard, padded, corrugated, or tear-resistant material. Envelopes constructed of heavy weight paper (that is, greater than 20 pound) or with security screening features. Cardstock (such as is used for greeting cards and post cards) Greeting cards and postcards are not allowed. There are no changes to the Legal mail requirements. This information is also being provided to your friends and family in the Visiting lobby, via the F&F emailed newsletter, and on the DOC Facebook page.

Srci Physical Plant has an opening for Paint Crew! In order to apply, all of the following criteria must be met (NO EXCEPTIONS): Clear conduct for 1 1/2 years (no major DR or Program Failures). Must already be housed in Complex 1-A, 1-B, or 1-C. Classification 3 or less. No history of escape, or arson. 10 years or less remaining on sentence.

JOB DUTIES: Applies coats of paint, varnish, stain, enamel, or lacquer to decorate and protect interior or exterior surfaces, trimmings, and fixtures of buildings and other structures. Reads Work Orders or receives instructions from Supervisor regarding painting. Smooths surfaces using sandpaper, brushes, or steel wool. Removes old paint from surfaces using paint remover, scraper, or wire brush to prepare surfaces for painting. Fills holes, cracks, and joints with caulk, putty, plaster or other filler using caulking gun and putty knife. Selects premixed paints, or mixes required portions of pigment, oil and thinning and drying substances to prepare paint that matches specified colors. • Removes fixtures such as pictures and electric switch covers from walls prior to painting by using a screwdriver. • Spreads drop cloths over floors and room to protect surfaces during painting. • Paints surfaces using brushes, spray gun, or paint rollers. • Sets up scaffolding or ladders to perform tasks above ground level. If you are interested in this program and meet all of the above requirements, send a completed Physical Plant Work Assignment Application; along with an Inmate Communication expressing your interest to Physical Plant (B344). The applications will be screened by members of the Physical Plant staff. Qualified applicants will need to pass a security screening before being contacted for an interview. Applications must be received by January 31, 2025.

Srci Visiting Center Barista Jobs Available Minimum Qualifications: *Must meet qualifications to live in Complex 1, *Incentive Level 3, *Custody Level 3 or Lower, *Minimum of 6 months of Clear Conduct. If Interested send an AIC Communication to Institution Work Programs (IWP) at mailbox B356. Qualified Candidates also need: *Good communication skills with Staff, other AIC workers and Visitors, *Ability to follow instructions, *Patience, *Ability and willingness to sanitize and deep clean, *Be self-motivated, *Knowledge of, and skills using equipment preferred, *Food Service Handlers Card and Barista 101 training/testing will be required once selected, *Days/ Hours may vary, *PRAS Point range – 12 to 14 points*

Food Services is Currently Hiring for Multiple Production Kitchen, Bakery, Special Events, and Staff Dining Positions. Applicants need to be motivated to succeed. Advancement is possible for the right applicants. Qualifications include: Minimum of 45 days clear conduct. Prior Food Service Experience (although not necessary for the right applicants) Ability to work early mornings or into the evening shift- AM and PM shifts available. An awareness of the need to complete work within tight timelines. An Ability to get along well with others and work in a job that is sometimes high- pressure.

Srci Physical Plant Plumber Recruitment Opportunity!! You must have a good work ethic & attitude, work in team environment, follow detailed instructions, and follow operational/safety guidelines. Have basic skills in: trouble shooting, hand tools, test equipment, carpentry, plumbing/janitorial, electrical/metal fabrication, mechanical/welding, and hydraulic/pneumatic systems. Be able to install and replace pipes, valves, drain systems, basins, tubs, faucets, lavatories, sinks, gates, hydrants, water heaters, dishwashers, other plumbing fixtures, pressure valves and equipment; repair breaks in pipes; clean and open drains and other lines; repair water pumps and heaters, steam traps condense lines; install and repair steam and gas systems; troubleshoots and repair SRCI systems. Be able to work with human waste. If you are interested in this program and meet all of the above requirements, send a completed "Physical Plant Work Assignment Application" along with an Inmate Communication expressing your interest to Physical Plant (B344). Applications need to be submitted through the mail system, if submitted differently they will not be processed. The applications will be screened by members of the Physical Plant Staff.
