Production Kitchen News- Production Kitchen is currently having the tile floor removed. This includes Dry Storage and all coolers/freezers, Bakery, Meat and Veggie room, Scullery, and Staff Dining Scullery. Days of operations are every Tuesday and Thursday. This project will be ongoing for approximately two (2) month time period.

While Production Kitchen is under construction on Tuesday and Thursday, the following changes will occur:

- **Lunch and Dinner menu will swap places.** Example: 02/13/2025 in Complexes, lunch will be pizza with hot veggies and dinner will cold ham and cheese with hot veggies. DSU will have the same swap with hot veggies at lunch but will receive cold cut veggies for the dinner meal.
- If signing up for a Meat Alternative Tray, keep in mind that on Tuesday and Thursday lunch is now being served for dinner. Dinner is now being served for lunch.
- Menu items will not change unless substitution is required per product availability.
- **Please be advised! AIC’s in DSU/IMU should note that pizza will be served for lunch every Thursday when signing up or their Meat Alternative trays for the week.**
