
MOVIE SCHEDULE



Production Kitchen News Production Kitchen is currently having the tile floor removed.



This includes Dry Storage and all coolers/freezers, Bakery, Meat and Veggie room, Scul-lery, and Staff Dining Scullery. Days of operations are every Tuesday and Thursday. This pro-ject will be ongoing for approximately two (2) month time period. While Production Kitchen is under construction on Tuesday and Thursday, the following changes will occur:

“Spring-Summer 2025” menu will begin on April 15, 2025. The new menu will reflect lunch and dinner already switched, as the tile project is still ongoing. No more weekly menu changes will be posted in the Chow Halls. Meaning the menu posted in Units will be served as is. Menu items will not change unless sub-stitution is required per product availability. When signing up for a Meat Alternative tray, review the “Spring-Summer 2025” menu, as it will be updated with the swapping of lunch and dinner. Once the tile re-moval project is complete, “Spring-Summer 2025” menu will revert to the originally written menu, switch-ing lunch back to dinner and dinner back to lunch. Notification will be given prior to menu changes.
