Must be Incentive level 3** * On the CD 28 purpose line write: **Marshmallow Fluff, make your CD-28 out to account #2457**. Attach signed CD-28 to a kyte and place in the kyte box on your complex. Send to: **Snake River Community Alliance Club B250**. Make sure all information is filled out properly, stamped, and is signed by your unit officer (**incomplete or illegible CD-28's will not be processed**). Refunds will not be given to AIC's that are unable to attend due to their own actions. You may only purchase one. Deadline to apply is June 09, 2025. 80% of the proceeds will go to the Oasis House in Ontario, Oregon to help support the homeless population with hygiene items, blankets, food, etc. The remaining 20% of the funds will go towards and event (pending approval) for a Complex 1 Yard Band Concert hotdog feed. **Cost is \$6.00 per jar!**

ACCEPTING APPLICANTS FOR SRCI VISITING CENTER BARISTA! Minimum Qualifications: *Must meet qualifications to live in Complex 1, *Incentive Level 3, *Custody Level 3 or Lower, *Minimum of 6 months of Clear Conduct. If Interested send an AIC Communication to Institution Work Programs (IWP) at mailbox B356. Qualified Candidates also need: *Good communication skills with Staff, other AIC workers and Visitors, *Ability to follow instructions, *Patience, *Ability and willingness to sanitize and deep clean, *Be self-motivated, *Knowledge of, and skills using equipment preferred, *Food Service Handlers Card and Barista 101 training/testing will be required once selected *Days/Hours may vary, *PRAS Point range – 12 to 14 points*

Behavioral Health Services (BHS) is now recruiting candidates to serve as Peer Companions! We are currently seeking individuals at SRCI that are committed to promoting mental wellness and have an interest in helping others. This is a paid, primary position, with varied working hours/days, and cannot be held with other paid positions. Individuals selected for this position will receive initial and on-going training from or identified by Behavioral Health Services, as well as ongoing supervision toward skill development. Selected candidates will receive on-going training for the position through job shadowing, individual skills coaching, and ongoing staff supervision. **Minimum Qualifications:** Clear conduct for 1 year * In compliance with your Oregon Corrections Plan * Treatment compliance if you receive Behavioral Health Services yourself * Engaged in positive, pro-social programming or activities * Ability to attend all the required training * Willingness to commit to the position as your only job for a minimum of 1 year * Ability to participate in physical activities. **Interested candidates will need to complete an AIC application. In addition to this application, please submit a letter that includes the following:** *Why do I want to be a Peer Companion? * How do I meet each of the minimum required qualifications for this position?

Following a review of all applications by BHS, qualified applicants will be further screened to include the AIC's assigned Correctional Counselor, past work supervisors, and Security staff. Following this screening process, AIC's will be notified and scheduled for a formal interview. Applications and letters must be received by BHS no later than **June 30, 2025**.
