At the time of the event if participants are NOT the appropriate Incentive level (3) will not be allowed to participate. All orders must be received to M. Behavioral Health Services (BHS) is now recruiting candidates to serve as Peer Companions! We are currently seeking individuals at SRCI that are committed to promoting mental wellness and have an interest in helping others. This is a paid, primary position, with varied working hours/days, and cannot be held with other paid positions. Individuals selected for this position will receive initial and on-going training from or identified by Behavioral Health Services, as well as ongoing supervision toward skill development. Selected candidates will receive on-going training for the position through job shadowing, individual skills coaching, and ongoing staff supervision. **Minimum Qualifications:** Clear conduct for 1 year * In compliance with your Oregon Corrections Plan * Treatment compliance if you receive Behavioral Health Services yourself * Engaged in positive, pro-social programming or activities * Ability to attend all the required training * Willingness to commit to the position as your only job for a minimum of 1 year * Ability to participate in physical activities. **Interested candidates will need to complete an AIC application. In addition to this application, please submit a letter that includes the following:** *Why do I want to be a Peer Companion? * How do I meet each of the minimum required qualifications for this position?

Following a review of all applications by BHS, qualified applicants will be further screened to include the AIC's assigned Correctional Counselor, past work supervisors, and Security staff. Following this screening process, AIC's will be notified and scheduled for a formal interview. Applications and letters must be received by BHS no later than **June 30, 2025**.

SRCI Physical Plant has an opening for a full-time Garden Tech. In order to apply, all of the following criteria must be met (no exceptions): • Clear conduct for 1 1/2 years (No Major DR or Program Failures) • Must already be housed in Complex 1-A, 1-B, or 1-C • Classification 3 or less • No history of escape, or arson • 10 years or less remaining on sentence Responsible for planting and maintaining Physical Plant gardens; coordination of the irrigation system, and systematic watering of plant life. Also performs the duties of plant care, equipment area maintenance/checks, and other duties as assigned. You must have a general knowledge of all various hand tools, work well with others and take direction, able to complete assigned tasks, and able to troubleshoot problems. If you are interested in this program and meet all of the above requirements, send a completed Physical Plant Work Assignment Application; along with an Inmate Communication expressing your interest to Physical Plant (B344). The applications will be screened by members of the Physical Plant staff. Qualified applicants will need to pass a security screening before being contacted for an interview. Applications must be received by June 13, 2025.
