Ice Melt Training

STORAGE! Improper storage of ice melt can cause breakdown of the chemicals that make ice melt viable. Here are some tips for storing it properly:

Per ice melt vendors around the globe...AKA Google:

Keep it airtight! Store opened ice melt in an airtight container to prevent it from absorbing moisture from the air, which can cause it to clump, harden, and degrade.

Store it away from moisture and air: Keep ice melt away from moisture, air, and sunlight.

Store it in a dry place: Store ice melt in a dry place, but not in an attic or on shelves.

Cover it with a dark wrap: Cover ice melt with a dark wrap to protect it from ultraviolet light, which can make it brittle and less effective.

Store it away from other chemicals: Store ice melt away from other chemicals, such as rat poison.

Store unopened bags flat: If you have unopened bags of ice melt, store them lying flat in a dry area.

Some bags don't seal well if stored on end.

Store pallets outdoors: If you have pallets of ice melt covered by a plastic shroud, you can store them outdoors on a well-drained surface. If the shroud is damaged, store the pallets indoors or under a waterproof covering.

Food Services News **Tree Nut, Sesame, Soy, and Milk Allergy Notice!** AICs with tree nut and sesame allergies, who experience anaphylactic reactions, need to report their allergy to Health Services. Health Services already tracks AICs with milk and soy allergies. Food Services just purchased Toasted Oats (Toasted O's), a cereal we have purchased in the past. This cereal is processed in the same facility as tree nuts (almonds), sesame, soy, and milk derivatives (ingredients made from milk). To avoid exposure, you must ask Foodservice staff what dry cereal is being served then self-select by asking for no dry cereal when Toasted Oats are served. During the Fall-Winter 2025-26 dry cereal is on the menu twice weekly. However, institutions may make changes anytime, without notice.

Special Religious Observances For facility planning and programming purposes there are sign-up deadlines and requirements for special religious observances including the following religious traditions: Judaism, Islam, Asatru, Druid, Pagan, Odinist, Wicca, Buddhism, Catholic/Protestant, LDS, Native American, Jehovah Witness. AICs who want to participate in special religious observances should contact the Chapel for information at least two months before any special religious observance dates to ensure they meet those deadlines and requirements. The Chapel will then provide information regarding sign up requirements and deadlines. The Chaplain is not responsible for AICs who fail to meet the sign-up deadline. Exceptions include AICs who have recently transferred into the facility.
