Seasonal Ice Melt Training for Grounds Crews

TRAINING #1 - Care of Spreader and Ice Melt Product - *NOTE* Spreaders range in price from \$150 to \$500* To avoid breaking spreader, please make sure ice melt is stored in a dry area and bag is closed to avoid clumping. Put on rubber gloves and break-up clumps before use in spreader so spreader blades do not break. To avoid using too much ice melt. Place spreader on the setting that sends out the least amount of ice melt. One cup of ice melt equals one driveway or ten (10) sidewalk squares. More is NOT best!

Snake River Correctional Institution is pleased to announce a Valentine's Day Visiting Luncheon for Adults in Custody (AICs) and their family members, friends, or loved ones. This special event will take place on February 13, 2026, at the SRCI Visiting Center and will be held as an all-day visiting luncheon. This luncheon is designed to support normalization and humanization, providing AICs the opportunity to share a meaningful meal and quality time with those who matter most on a holiday that celebrates connection and love. Events like this play an important role in strengthening family bonds, promoting positive relationships, and supporting our ongoing efforts to reduce recidivism within the correctional setting. The visiting lunch meal will include:

***Hoagie sandwiches with Meat alternative option *(Must note on request) *Potato chips *Fresh fruit
*A frosted cupcake***

The cost of the visiting lunch is \$2.63 per meal. Only meals for visiting family members or guests must be purchased. AICs attending the luncheon will NOT be required to purchase a meal. This luncheon will be a "First Come First Serve" event, with AICs who submitted CD28 for the last luncheon given Priority for this event. If you submitted a CD28 & Kyte for the last luncheon and would like to attend this one, please Re-Submit your kyte and CD28 #2879 and you will be placed on the list as priority over new submissions. Send your request Kyte & CD28 Account Number 2879 to box B339. Fill out your CD28 2879 & Kyte completely and legibly in pen: If you do not put name, SID, Bunk #, it will be sent back to you. Make sure to place your signature on your CD 28 and that it is stamped and verified by a Correctional Officer. **The cut off date to request to participate in this current luncheon will be January 28th, 2026. The first 40 AICs that meet criteria above will be able to attend this luncheon event..** Visitors must be on your current approved list, the complete names of the visitors attending must be listed on an attached AIC communication form to M. Vokral. This information will be provided to the Visiting Room Staff for seating arrangement purposes. **Reminder** special visits or additional visitors **MUST** be requested and approved by Visiting Sergeant N. Nguyen. The morning and afternoon visiting session will be held exclusively for the participants of the visiting lunch event. Visitors must arrive between the hours of 8:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. in order to attend luncheon in order to allow time for family members to process into the institution. All AICs will be given a confirmation kyte when they are placed on the list (or placed on the waiting list once the event is full) the week of February 1st 2026.

Physical Plant Orderly Position Available! SRCI Physical Plant has an opening for an AIC Orderly position. In order to apply, all of the following criteria must be met (no exceptions): ***Clear conduct for 1 1/2 years (No Major DR or Program Failures) *Must be housed in Complex 1 *Classification 3 or less *10 years or less remaining on sentence.** You must have a good work ethic & attitude, ability to communicate with others, work in a team environment, understand detailed instructions, and follow operational/safety guidelines. You must have knowledge in the safe use of cleaning agents. Duties include: wash/sanitize toilets & sinks, restock disposables (paper towels, toilet paper, cups, soap, etc), clean mirrors/windows, ensure spaces are prepared for the next day by taking out trash, and other applicable custodial duties. The position also involves floor maintenance, sweeping, mopping, stripping, waxing, ability to lift heavy objects, and other duties as assigned. **If you are interested in this program and meet all of the above requirements, send a completed "Physical Plant Work Assignment Application" expressing your interest to Physical Plant (B344).** The applications will be screened by members of the Physical Plant Staff. Qualified applicants will need to pass a security screening before being contacted for an interview. **Submit application by January 30, 2026.**

SRCI Physical Plant has an opening for an AIC Water Heater position In order to apply, all of the following criteria must be met, no exceptions: ***Clear conduct for 1 1/2 years (No Major DR or Program Failures) *Must be eligible to be housed in 2I, 2J, 3I, or 3J *Classification 3 or less *No history of escape, or arson *10 years or less remaining on sentence*** You must have a good work ethic & attitude, be able to work in a team environment, follow detailed instructions, and adhere to operational/safety guidelines. Skilled water heater repair, maintenance and replacement experience preferred. Duties include but are not limited to: Maintain and repair hot water heaters. Diagnose and repair of electronic, mechanical and electrical components of these systems. Have basic skills in: trouble shooting, hand tools, test equipment, plumbing, electrical/metal fabrication, mechanical/welding, and hydraulic/pneumatic systems. if you are interested in this program and meet all of the above requirements, send a completed "Physical Plant Work Assignment Application" along with an AIC Communication expressing your interest to Physical Plant (B344).
