ICE MELT TRAINING

STORAGE! Improper storage of ice melt can cause breakdown of the chemicals that make ice melt viable. Here are some tips for storing it properly: *Per ice melt vendors around the globe...AKA Google:*

Keep it airtight! Store opened ice melt in an airtight container to prevent it from absorbing moisture from the air, which can cause it to clump, harden, and degrade. Store it away from moisture and air: Keep ice melt away from moisture, air, and sunlight. Store it in a dry place: Store ice melt in a dry place, but not in an attic or on shelves.

Cover it with a dark wrap: Cover ice melt with a dark wrap to protect it from ultraviolet light, which can make it brittle and less effective.

Store it away from other chemicals: Store ice melt away from other chemicals, such as rat poison.

Store unopened bags flat: If you have unopened bags of ice melt, store them lying flat in a dry area. Some bags don't seal well if stored on end.

Store pallets outdoors: If you have pallets of ice melt covered by a plastic shroud, you can store them outdoors on a well-drained surface. If the shroud is damaged, store the pallets indoors or under a water-proof covering.

SRCI Physical Plant has an opening for an AIC Water Heater position In order to apply, all of the following criteria must be met, no exceptions: ***Clear conduct for 1 1/2 years (No Major DR or Program Failures) *Must be eligible to be housed in 2I, 2J, 3I, or 3J *Classification 3 or less *No history of escape, or arson *10 years or less remaining on sentence*** You must have a good work ethic & attitude, be able to work in a team environment, follow detailed instructions, and adhere to operational/safety guidelines. Skilled water heater repair, maintenance and replacement experience preferred. Duties include but are not limited to: Maintain and repair hot water heaters. Diagnose and repair of electronic, mechanical and electrical components of these systems. Have basic skills in: trouble shooting, hand tools, test equipment, plumbing, electrical/metal fabrication, mechanical/welding, and hydraulic/pneumatic systems. if you are interested in this program and meet all of the above requirements, send a completed "Physical Plant Work Assignment Application" along with an AIC Communication expressing your interest to Physical Plant (B344). The applications will be screened by members of the Physical Plant Staff. Qualified applicants will go through an interview and will need to pass a security screening before being hired. **Submit applications by February 20th, 2026.**

Minimum Qualifications: ***Must meet qualifications to live in Complex 1, *Incentive Level 3, *Custody Level 3 or Lower, *Minimum of 6 months of Clear Conduct. If Interested send an AIC Communication to Institution Work Programs (IWP) at mailbox B356. Qualified Candidates also need: *Good communication skills with Staff, other AIC workers and Visitors, *Ability to follow instructions, *Patience, *Ability and willingness to sanitize and deep clean, *Be self-motivated, *Knowledge of, and skills using equipment preferred, *Food Service Handlers Card and Barista 101 training/testing will be required once selected *Days/Hours may vary, *PRAS Point range – 12 to 14 points***
